

PASSWORD SECURITY

STAY SAFE ONLINE

TIP 01

DON'T REUSE PASSWORDS

Use a different password for each account to prevent hackers getting access to all your accounts.

11P 02

AVOID SEQUENTIAL NUMBERS

Don't use passwords with sequential numbers, such as password1 and password2.

03

USE LONG PASSPHRASES

Use long easy to remember passphrases instead of short, hard-to-remember passwords. Aim for 14 or more characters.

11P 04

ONLY CHANGE WHEN NECESSARY

Change passwords only when there's a potential threat or you suspect unauthorised access to your account.

TIP **05**

AVOID PERSONAL INFORMATION

Don't use easily guessable personal info like name, birthday, address, or family member's names as your password.

TIP **06**

USE MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

Use MFA with an authentication app whenever possible. Avoid using SMS for MFA

TIP 07

STORE PASSWORDS IN A VAULT

Use a secure password manager to store all your passwords securely in one place.

^{TIP} 08

PROTECT FROM PRYING EYES

Keep passwords private, don't write them down or save them in a file, and dont enter them when someone is watching.

^{TIP} 09

KEEP IT SECRET, KEEP IT SAFE

Don't share passwords with anyone. Create separate logins if needed.

™ 10

CHANGE IMMEDIATELY IF UNSURE

Change your password immediately if you suspect an account has been compromised or someone else knows it.
